Libya has a long history with Christianity. Simon of Cyrene, who carried the cross of Jesus, was from Libya. Cyrenian Christian Jews took the gospel back to Libya after Pentecost. But Islam largely replaced Christianity in the seventh century. Much of the population of Libya was also once nomadic, living in tents. Today, most have settled down in towns and cities along the coast and live in apartment blocks or homes. Their old way of life is quickly fading.

Ministry Obstacles

Libyan Arabs have not had the opportunity to understand what Christians believe about Christ. Access to Christian information is restricted and proselytizing is prohibited.
